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LOST VILLAGES HISTORICAL SOCIETY

For travelers in and around the Lost Villages Museum site, Christmas was just a little more festive with the bright lights and Christmas displays. 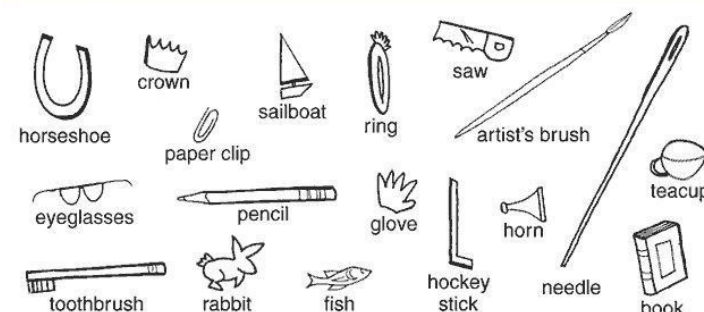

“Exactly,” I said.

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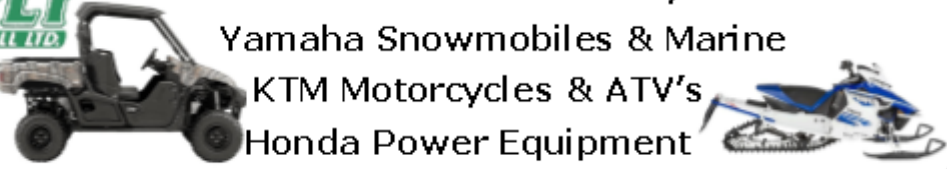
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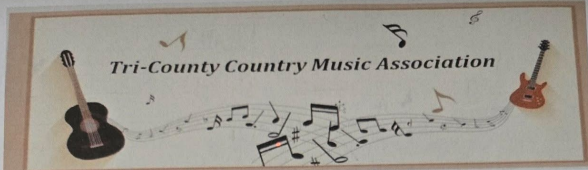




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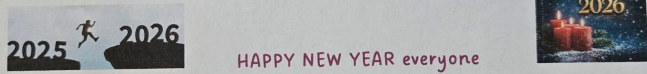
