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LOST VILLAGES HISTORICAL SOCIETY

The first meeting of the historical society was held on Monday, February 16th, at the Riverdale Terrace Retirement Residence, Second Street West, Cornwall. attendance for a general meeting. Author John Sliter brought out some very enthusiastic members and friends of the historical society, and he did not disappoint. Before our eyes, he opened up his recently published book, "Matriarchs of the Hoople Creek Loyalists", through a PowerPoint presentation. As well, he surprised many folks in the audience with detailed family connections to some of the matriarchs profiled in his book. There were a number of Hoople descendants in the audience, and it is fair to say that they and all attendees left with so much history to mull over. On February 17th, at Schnitzel's Restaurant in Cornwall, President Jim Brownell, brought a capacity crowd on a journey through the "Lands of the Lost Villages" by means of a slide presentation. Jim reach into the archives of the Lost Villages to find the photos to illustrate the family's relocation from Farran's Point to St Lawrence Seaway and Hydro Development projects of the 1950s and the relocation of inhabitant to the new towns of Long Sault and Ingleside. Three days later, on February 20th, Jim presented the same slide presentation to a captivated audience at the Riverdale Terrace Retirement Residence, Second Street West, Cornwall. The historical society is pleased to have Evan Bilmer, the Historical Interpreters Supervisor for 2025, back at the museum for a winter employment placement. Evan was hired in January 2026 and the placement will cover his part-time employment until the end of April. Evan is doing an amazing job at sorting, recording, and cataloging the Women's Institute collection at the Lost Villages Archives. We thank him for his dedication and hard work. It is wonderful to have this collection archived. The historical society has amassed a huge collection of photographs and documents from the estate of the late Vale (Marcellus) Brownell. What is wonderful with this collection is the fact that at least 80% of the photo collection has been identified, thanks to Vale and her late mother, Sarah "Sally" (Baker) Marcellus. What a gift to the historical society! As well, the documents reveal the complete details of the Marcellus family's relocation from Farran's Point to Ingleside, through Ontario Hydro projects of the 1950s and the relocation of inhabitant to the new towns of Long Sault and Ingleside.

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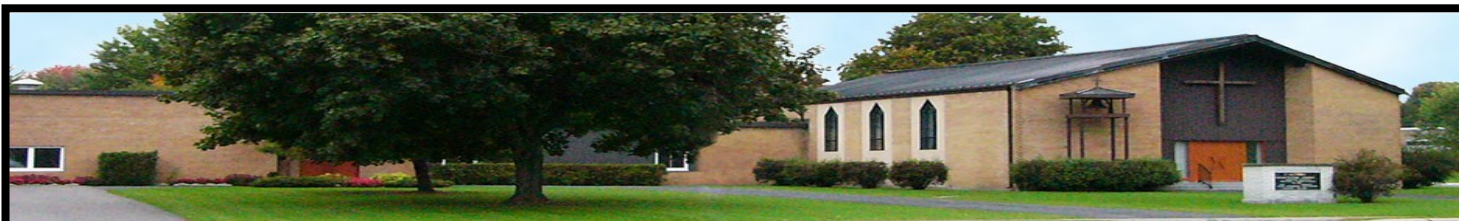

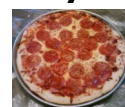
